 - 7) A proof of payment of the non-refundable administration fee must accompany this application
 - 8) Where the space provided is not adequate, the information should be attached as an addendum
 - 9) A separate application is required for each address where flora is cultivated at, sold from or harvested at

INFORMATION DOCUMENT FOR THE TO REGISTRATION OF PREMISES AND FOR A LICENSE TO GROW AND / OR SELL PROTECTED OR UNPROTECTED FLORA

I, the applicant, hereby declare that I take note of and understand:

- That the onus is on me to acquaint myself with all legislation pertaining to the growing, selling, transport and possession of protected and unprotected flora.
- That the onus is on me to acquaint myself with all legislation pertaining to the international trade (import / export) in protected and unprotected flora and that additional permits (e.g. CITES and/or Dept. of Agriculture) may be required.
- That the onus is on me to verify the current conservation status of any flora species that is in my possession or are to be acquired / cultivated / sold prior to such possession / acquisition / cultivation or sale on the SANBI Red List of South African Plants at <http://redlist.sanbi.org/> and/or <http://www.iucnredlist.org/> and/or <https://www.cites.org/eng/app/appendices.php>.
- That a registration certificate to grow and / or sell protected and unprotected flora does not authorise me to possess, cultivate, acquire by any means or trade in endangered flora.
- That the onus is on me to ascertain whether any additional permits or authorisations are required from other local / provincial and / or national authorities (e.g. municipal approval, permits from the National Department of Environmental Affairs to propagate or trade in listed alien and invasive species etc.)
- That I may only grow and / or sell protected and unprotected flora on or from registered premises.
- That I can apply for permits at my nearest CapeNature regional office.
- That any permit / license has an expiry date and that the onus is on me to apply for the renewal of my license to grow / sell protected or unprotected flora at least ninety (90) days prior to the expiration.
- That I must have the necessary license and / or permit in my possession prior to commencing any activity with any specimen of protected and unprotected flora.
- That a registration certificate does not authorise me to grow / sell / harvest protected or unprotected flora or the seed thereof without a valid accompanying license and / or permit.
- That the landowner's written permission containing 1) the full name and surname of the landowner, 2) the full name and surname of the picker, 3) the number and species of flora, 4) the date or dates of the picking and the 5) property name and number as it appears on the title deed in respect of which the permission is being granted must be in the picker's possession prior to the picking taking place and / or protected or unprotected flora or any part thereof is removed from the property.
- This landowner's confirmation of donation / sale and permission to remove the flora from the landowner's property must be kept in the possession of the holder of the permission for a period of at least two months from the date of issue or as long as the holder of the document is in possession of the flora. It must be available for inspection by a CapeNature official at any time that the holder is in possession of the flora concerned.
- That it is an offence to commence any activity with protected or unprotected flora without being in possession of a valid permit or license authorising that particular activity.
- That I must keep an invoice book in which the following information is specified: a) my full name and address, b) the full name and address of the buyer / receiver, c) the number and expiry date of my license to sell protected flora and d) the species name and quantity of each species which is being sold or donated.
- That I can be held responsible for reimbursement of the costs incurred by CapeNature to conduct an inspection if the minimum requirements for a permit / license are not met.
- That, in the case of repeated offences or failure to comply with permit conditions, it may lead to the cancellation of permits / licenses and/or the withholding of future permits / licenses.
- That, in the case of an offence regarding the specimen(s) contained in this application, the specimen(s) may be confiscated / seized by CapeNature.
